Important Notice: Temporary closure of Fuel Berth and Harbour Davit crane

We would like to inform you that due to essential maintenance work, there will be temporary disruptions to some of our services.

Fuel Berth Closure:

Please be advised that the fuel berth will be closed all day on Tuesday 31st October 2023

Harbour Davit Crane Out of Service:

Additionally, the harbour davit crane will not be operational on the same day.

These disruptions are necessary as the Council are undertaking a significant upgrade of the electrical infrastructure, including the renewal of electrical junction boxes.

We understand that these services are vital for many of you, and we sincerely apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

We are committed to ensuring that these upgrades are completed efficiently and with minimal disruption.

Alternative Arrangements:

We recommend that all berth holders plan their fuelling needs accordingly. Should you require crane services, please make alternative arrangements for this period.

Safety Notice:

For your safety, we also request that all berth holders and visitors refrain from accessing the affected areas during this time.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we work to improve our facilities. The DMG team will be working diligently to complete these upgrades promptly and ensure that services are restored as quickly as possible.
