MARINA RECEPTION

Our receptions are open but we ask that you telephone, radio or e-mail the office whenever possible. We are patrolling and monitoring the site as normal but would prefer a phone call or e-mail.

KEY COLLECTION

If you do need to collect or drop off keys, we can and will do this but for now, let's keep it to a minimum. Please bring your own keys with you.

CONTRACTORS

If you require a contractor to visit your boat, please let us know beforehand in writing. Only approved contractors may enter the site so please ensure you check with the marina reception first.

RAFTING OR MOORING

You must avoid rafting or mooring directly alongside any other vessel unless told to do so by a member of staff or in case of emergency.

TROLLEYS AND KEY PADS

We wipe these down with disinfectant on a regular basis but advise that you should take your own precautions before use or use disposable gloves.

CAR PARKING

Please park as normal where indicated but do try not to 'bump' into each other! Driving may be a little rusty!

TOILETS, SHOWERS AND THE LAUNDERETTE

Toilets, showers and laundry facilities are open as normal but are subject to additional deep cleaning and some queuing or inconvenience may occur. Some toilets and hand basins are cordoned off creating more space between users. Please do not be tempted to use these and respect Social Distancing.

GOVERNMENT ADVICE

- **Keep your contacts to immediate family or crew. Stay within your social 'bubble'.**
- **Maintain social distancing of the recommended 2.0m (or a boat length if you prefer!)**
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.**
- **When coughing or sneezing, do so into the crook of your elbow or into a disposable tissue.**
- **Should you feel unwell, please leave the site and if you fall ill within 3 days of a visit to us, please let us know so we can then take appropriate precautions.**
