



Local Notice to Mariners

Wednesday 31st August 1500 hrs to 2300 hrs

Pier & Slipway Closure, Restriction on paddleboard/kayaking/rowing activity

Mariners are advised that Snow Patrol will be playing in the vicinity of Bangor Marina and Harbour on Wednesday 31st August between 1500 hrs and 2300 hrs. In addition, the cruise ship 'The World' will be tendering passengers and guests throughout the day and evening.

To facilitate this concert and cruise ship visit please be advised of the following.

Eisenhower Pier – berthing restrictions

Vessels will not be permitted to berth alongside the Eisenhower Pier on Wednesday 31st August 2022

Harbour Slipway

The Harbour slipway will be closed from 1500 hrs to 2300 hrs on Wednesday 31st August. No launching/recovery of vessels and paddleboards.

Vehicular access restrictions – Commercial Pier

Vehicular access to the Commercial Pier for fish lorries and road tankers will not be permitted between 1500 hrs to 2300 hrs on Wednesday 31st August.

Harbour Restrictions - Paddleboarders and paddle/oar-powered vessels.

Paddleboarders and paddle/oar-powered vessels **will not** be permitted to use the Harbour between 1500 hrs and 2300 hrs on Wednesday 31st August 2022

BJ Marine Pontoon – berthing restrictions

In compliance with the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code, a Temporary Restricted Area (TRA) will be established on BJ Marines pontoon and bridgehead. BJ Marines pontoon will be closed to all except tender vessels, passengers and authorised staff on Wednesday 31st August.

Fuel Pontoon – berthing restrictions – 1st September

To facilitate 'The World' cruise ship call the fuel berth will be closed on 1st September 2022
