



Local Notice to Mariners

Wednesday 31st August

Berthing Allocations – 1200 hrs to 2200 hrs.

Any instruction given by the Berthing Master regarding safe navigation, berthing and safe speed must be observed.

Mariners are advised that there will be no allocation of temporary marina berths in the run-up to and during the Snow Patrol concert. (1200 hrs to 2200 hrs)

Safety vessels will patrol the Marina and Harbour during the concert - specific berths have been designated as 'safe landing berths' in the event of an emergency.

Vessels will be permitted to enter and leave the Marina and Harbour during the concert times, please call on VHF channel 11 for clearance.

Eisenhower Pier – berthing restrictions

Vessels will not be permitted to berth alongside the Eisenhower Pier on Wednesday 31st August 2022

Harbour Slipway

The Harbour slipway will be closed from 1500 hrs to 2300 hrs on Wednesday 31st August. No launching/recovery of vessels and paddleboards.

Vehicular access restrictions – Commercial Pier

Vehicular access to the Commercial Pier for fish lorries and road tankers will not be permitted between 1500 hrs to 2300 hrs on Wednesday 31st August.

Harbour Restrictions - Paddleboarders and paddle/oar-powered vessels.

Paddleboarders and paddle/oar-powered vessels **will not** be permitted to use the Harbour between 1500 hrs and 2300 hrs on Wednesday 31st August 2022

BJ Marine Pontoon – berthing restrictions

In compliance with the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code, a Temporary Restricted Area (TRA) will be established on BJ Marines pontoon and bridgehead. BJ Marines pontoon will be closed to all except tender vessels, passengers and authorised staff on Wednesday 31st August.
