To accommodate Royal Naval visits and to facilitate the Sea Bangor event, Mariners are advised that berthing alongside the Eisenhower Pier will not be permitted on Friday 2nd June, Saturday 3rd June, Sunday 4th June & Monday 5th June 2023.

The Harbour will close while two Royal Naval vessels manoeuvre alongside and when they depart.

Artemis Display

The 12M Artemis eFoil propelled multi-purpose workboat is the world's first high-speed 100% electric foiling commercial vessel. This vessel provides both speed, comfort range, minimal wake and a 70% reduction in energy costs and is the type of technology that will power the new Bangor to Belfast fast passenger ferry.

The Pioneer of Belfast will demonstrate the new electric foiling technology outside Bangor Harbour Limits on Saturday and Sunday. Seacliff Road will offer the best viewing point.
